About the project

Project NEW ERA – "New Entrepreneurs in Rural Areas" is meant to tackle the issues of youth entrepreneurship in the context of rural development and youth unemployment. We recognized the issues of developing rural areas because these areas are as important for youth as urban areas and we think that there is strong need to also focus on these areas.

Our main objectives: to promote youth entrepreneurship, learn how to motivate investment in rural areas, provide proper tools for self-development of young leaders.

We also want to emphasize the importance of active European citizenship in the context of the inter-cultural dialogue. The project is meant to share the good practices of entrepreneurship through different workshops and trainings held by competent trainers and experts in the field in order to provide youth with all the necessary tools for accomplishing the main objectives of the project.

We would like to enrich the knowledge of youngsters regarding entrepreneurship as well as give them opportunity to express their opinion and improve their skills in the same field. On the other hand, we would like

to raise awareness about the big gap between rural and urban areas because we considered that youngsters coming from rural areas are facing difficulties in their daily life.

The methods would provide a mixture of theory and practice, sharing and exchanging opinions, expertise and experiences in the field of entrepreneurship. Participants will complete a series of exercises designed to discover the answers by themselves and then put into practice what they have learned. Each thematic module includes interactive sessions that introduce participants to entrepreneurship concepts and tools and serve as the foundation for the practical activities and case studies. Participants then move on to work with a set of hands-on tasks designed around realistic scenarios, which provide practical experience in a context that simulates real work environments. Collaborative work is another core element of the course. Participants will engage in peer-reviews and discussion groups. Creative writing and thinking techniques will help to look for innovative solutions, team-builders and energizers will ensure positive, open and safe atmosphere.

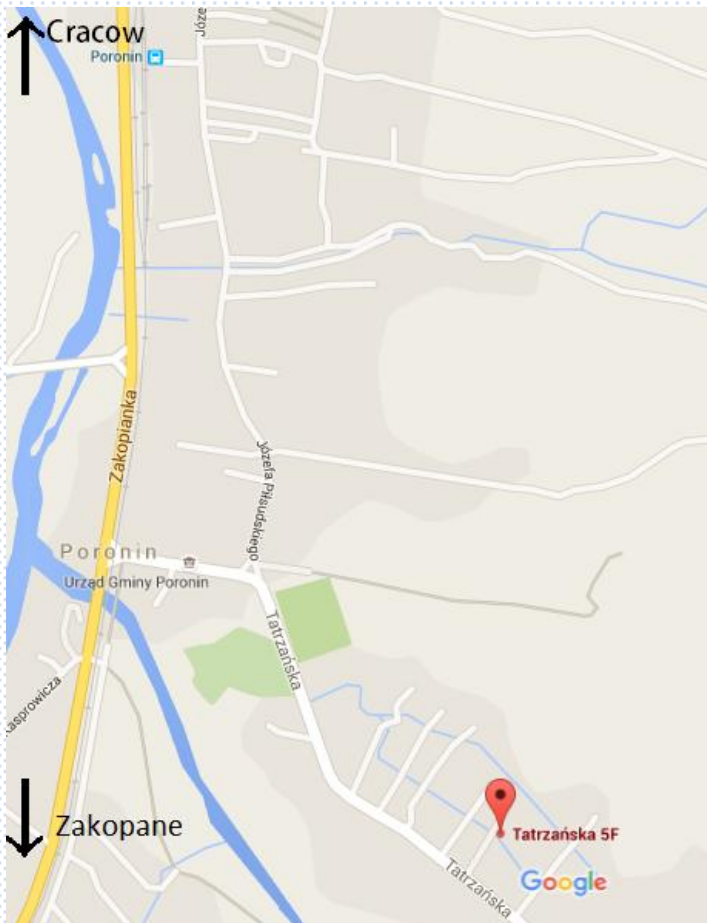

Transport to Poronin



Poronin is a village just next to Zakopane, Polish winter capital. The best way to get there is to travel by car or by bus, you may also travel by train. Therefore please contact the person who is in charge of TC in your NGO and consult travel options with him/her.

If you are coming by plane, the nearest airport is in Kraków, Balice. Later you take the bus (or train) to Zakopane/Poronin, it costs about 15/30 PLN (4/8 EUR).

! Do not buy any tickets before our approval. You can use max in general 2 days for your

travel.

Travel costs

Travel costs are covered by the program up to the amount indicated below. They will be reimbursed to the participants or the sending organization upon the presentation of all the original tickets and receipts, including for the return. Note that all participants must leave and come back to their sending country within a reasonable amount of time from the project' s activities (no more than 2 days) in order to be eligible for reimbursement. According to

the new Erasmus+ program you can travel by car, which is cheaper and we recommend you this way.

Please check in with us or your sending organization before proceeding to purchase any tickets. No matter what are you traveling with, please keep tickets or bills for the gas from the day of the travel! We will reimburse the travel costs only due to those documents, during an exchange.

Weather

October is a month of Autumn in Poland. It is usually warm, cool – with an average temperature of 8 – 15C. Be aware the weather may vary, just like in all mountains. Please be prepared for such conditions, take warm clothes and a coat.

Preparation

Please be prepared to briefly present your organisation during the training.

Timetable consist also trip to Tatra Mountains (If weather will allows us to), in this case please notify to take some comfortable and proper shoes for walking.

During the Training Course there will be organized Intercultural Evening, therefore go please be ready to present your country and bring some materials, including your national drinks and snacks.

Basic rules of this Training Course: being active, on time, no smoking during activities, non alcoholic policy (there is allowed to drink only during "intercultural evenings")

Youthpass

All participants receive Youthpass certificates. Youthpass is a part of the European Commission' s strategy to foster the recognition of non-formal learning. It is available for projects funded by Erasmus+:

Youth in Action (2014–2020) As a tool to document and recognise learning outcomes, it puts policy into practice and practice into policy:

- While creating their Youthpass Certificate together with a support person, the participants of the projects have the possibility to describe what they have done in their project and which competences they have acquired. Thus, Youthpass supports the reflection upon the personal non-formal learning process and outcomes.
- Being a Europe-wide validation instrument for non-formal learning in the youth field, Youthpass contributes to strengthening the social recognition of youth work.
- Describing the added value of the project, Youthpass supports active European citizenship of young people and of youth workers.
- Youthpass also aims at supporting the employability of young people and of youth workers by documenting the acquisition of key competences on a certificate.
